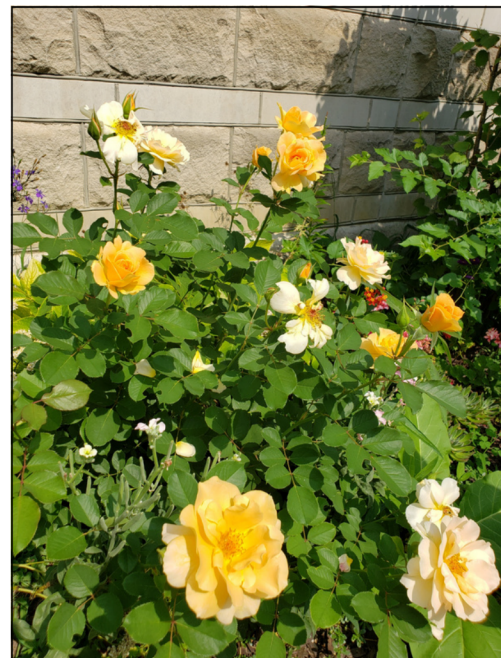

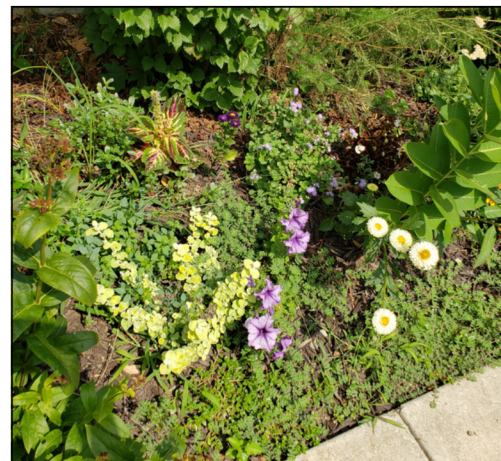




# The beauty of nature abounds at GPL
