Perfect! As long as they're healthy, bring them to the GPL Plant Cuttings & Starts Swap!

On Thursday, May 4th, we'll be hosting a plant swap from 1 to 3 p.m. in the third floor conference room. Since this is a swap, you can come and

go as you please between 1 and 3, but those coming earlier will obviously get the first pick. So you could drop off a pepper start and leave with a marigold, or bring a houseplant cutting and leave with a transplanted daylily. Selection will be based on what is donated.

Due to the nature of this event, we are asking that all patrons please register no later than April 28th to Kelly by emailing her at [kelly@greenville-publiclibrary.org](mailto:kelly@greenville-publiclibrary.org) or by calling the library. Those

registering will be asked to drop off all cuttings, starts, and transplants on May 3rd during regular business hours so we can assess and organize the plants before the event.

For those without plants to share, the Growing Harvest Seed Library is always available and contains a wide variety of high-quality seeds for "borrowing". If you are unable to stop in and browse, contact Kelly and she will get you a list of seeds to choose from, then pack up your order for pick up.

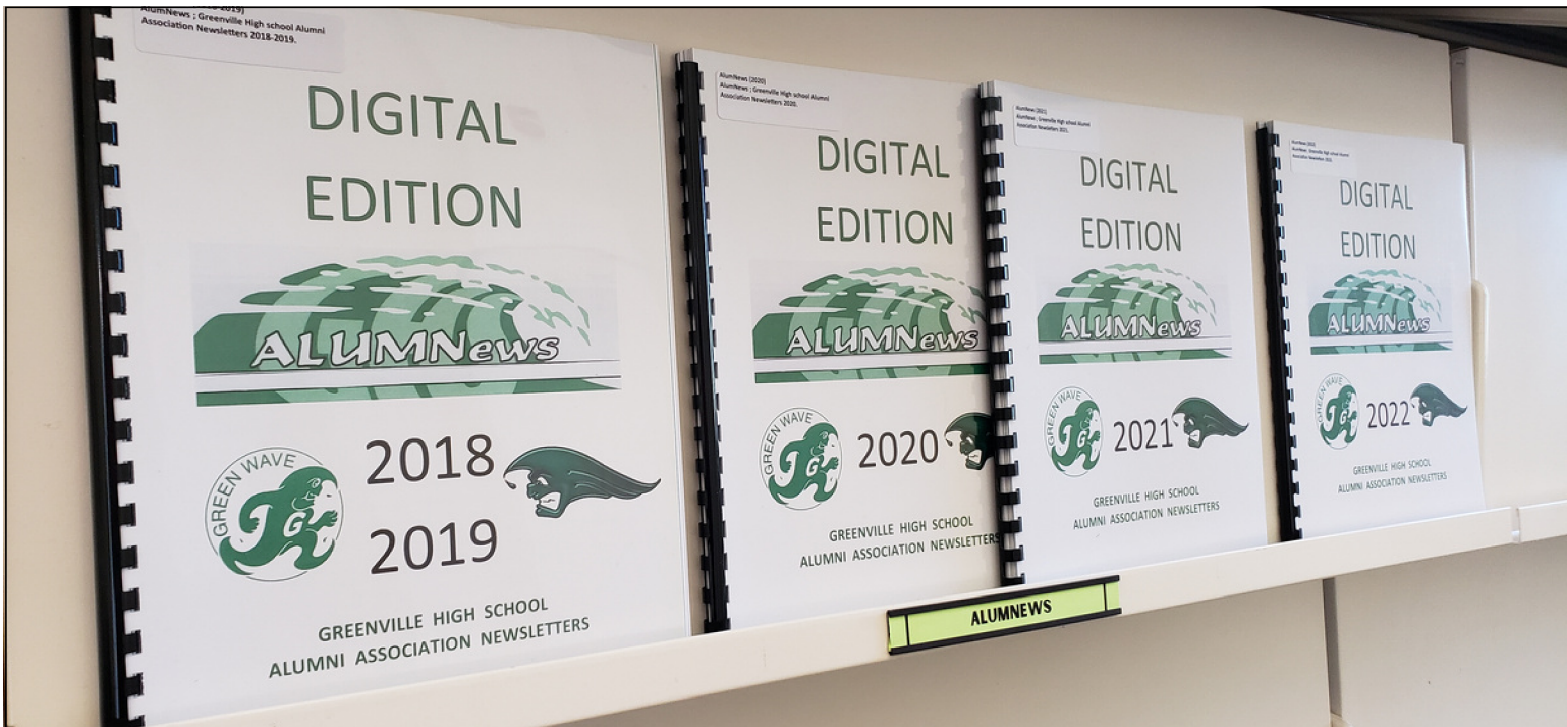
## May Movie Matinee
